Founding member of the Canadian Electroacoustic Community (CEC). Member of the Association pour la création et la recherche électroacoustiques du Québec (ACREQ). Founding member of Réseaux, a concert production society. Prize-winner of the Bourges (France, 1986, 1988), the Phonurgia-Nova (Arles, France, 1986 and 1987), the Luigi Russolo (Varese, Italy, 1989, 1990), Noroit-Léonce Petitot (Arras, France, 1991) and Stockholm (Sweden, 1992) international competitions. Composer in residence at studios in Ohain (Belgium, 1987), Bourges (France, 1988), Banff (Canada, 1989, 1992) and Paris (France, 1990). Lecturer in acoustics, electroacoustics and psychoacoustics at the Music Faculty of the Université de Montréal since 1988. Associate composer of the Canadian Music Centre.

Specializes in acousmatic composition (since 1984), his work adopts the perspective of a «cinema for the ear» where the meaning as well as the sound contributes to the composition.
